

# NUECES WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION

## Rate/Fee Notice

The Nueces Water Supply Corporation Board of Directors met on November 26, 2018 to adopt a budget for Fiscal Year 2019 which begins January 1, 2019. As part of the budget process, the Board reviewed monthly minimums and water rates and adopted new rates (below), which will be reflected in your **February 2019 bill**. These rates were last changed four (4) years ago in January 2015.

1. The monthly minimums will *increase* as follows:

Meter Size	Current Minimum	New Minimum	2019 Increase
5/8"	\$29.50	\$30.35	\$0.85
3/4"	\$34.26	\$35.54	\$1.28
1"	\$68.01	\$70.14	\$2.13
2"/compound	\$151.00	\$157.80	\$6.80

2. The water rates will *increase* by 25 cents per 1000 gallons. NWSC purchases treated water from the South Texas Water Authority (STWA), which buys water from the City of Corpus Christi. That cost is passed through to NWSC. In January 2015 the City of Corpus Christi rate was about \$2.35 per 1000 gallons. Based on the City's recent Ordinance adoption, this cost will increase to \$2.56 per thousand gallons as of January 2019. Below are the changes to the three (3) tiers of rates.

Number of Gallons	Current Rate	2019 Rate
0 - 10,000	\$3.30	\$3.55
10,001 - 20,000	\$3.35	\$3.60
20,001+	\$3.40	\$3.65

Below is a sample for a 5/8" residential meter using 7,000 gallons in a month.

Monthly Minimum	\$29.50	\$30.35
Gallons Usage	\$23.10	\$24.85
TCEQ Fee (0.5%)	\$0.26	\$0.28
Total	\$52.86	\$55.48
